## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of and funding for additional program
3	of all-inclusive care for the elderly (PACE) sites; making an
4	appropriation.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 32.0534 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 32.0534. ADDITIONAL PACE PROGRAM SITES. (a) The
9	commission shall establish three PACE program sites that are in
10	addition to the PACE program sites operating before September 1,
11	2023. Each of the additional sites must:
12	(1) have capacity to serve a maximum of 300 program
13	slots; and
14	(2) be administered by an entity with available
15	facility space and demonstrated administrative capacity.
16	(b) A PACE program site established under Subsection (a)
17	must:
18	(1) support the goals of:
19	(A) increased access to health care services;
20	(B) options for eligible individuals; and
21	(C) improved public health outcomes;
22	(2) comply with Section 32.053 and all regulatory
23	requirements; and
24	(3) be approved as a provider agency by the Centers for

- 1 Medicare and Medicaid Services.
- 2 <u>(c) If money appropriated by the legislature</u> to the
- 3 commission for purposes of this section is insufficient to fund the
- 4 additional slots described by Subsection (a) for a state fiscal
- 5 biennium, the executive commissioner shall submit a written request
- 6 to the Legislative Budget Board and the governor for approval to
- 7 transfer money appropriated to the commission for the biennium for
- 8 other purposes to fund the additional slots. The request is
- 9 considered approved unless the Legislative Budget Board or the
- 10 governor issues a written disapproval of the request not later than
- 11 the 30th business day after the date Legislative Budget Board staff
- 12 conclude a review of the request and forward the review to the chair
- 13 of the house appropriations committee, the chair of the senate
- 14 finance committee, the speaker of the house of representatives, and
- 15 the lieutenant governor. Any request for additional information
- 16 the Legislative Budget Board makes tolls the counting of the 30
- 17 business days.
- 18 (d) On the request of the commission, the Legislative Budget
- 19 Board, or the governor, a PACE program provider shall provide
- 20 information related to the provider's actual costs, caseloads, and
- 21 services for purposes of this section.
- SECTION 2. The amount of \$16.48 million is appropriated
- 23 from the general revenue fund to the Health and Human Services
- 24 Commission for the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2023,
- 25 for the purpose of establishing additional program of all-inclusive
- 26 care for the elderly (PACE) sites in accordance with Section
- 27 32.0534, Human Resources Code, as added by this Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 2 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 3 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 4 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 5 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 6 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
