Section 1023.054(a), Special District Local Laws 14 Code, is amended to read as follows: 15 If a [A] vacancy occurs in the office of director, the 16 (a) remaining directors shall appoint a director [shall be filled] for 17 the unexpired term [at the next regular election]. 18 19 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to the qualifications required for membership of the board of directors of 20 the Eastland Memorial Hospital District do not affect the 21 22 entitlement of a director serving on the board immediately before the effective date of this Act to continue to carry out the 23 functions of the board for the remainder of the director's term. 1 changes in law apply only to a member of the board of directors 2 elected or appointed on or after the effective date of this Act. 3 This Act does not prohibit a person who is a member of the board on 4 the effective date of this Act from being reelected or reappointed 5 to the board if the person has the qualifications required for 6 membership under Section 1023.053, Special District Local Laws 7 Code, as amended by this Act.
