Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, is amended 5 to read as follows: 6 7 (a) A local innovation plan may not provide for the exemption of a district designated as a district of innovation from 8 9 the following provisions of this title: (1) a state or federal requirement applicable to an 10 11 open-enrollment charter school operating under Subchapter D, 12 Chapter 12; 13 (2) Subchapters A, C, D, and E, Chapter 11, except that 14 a district may be exempt from Sections 11.1511(b)(5) and (14) and Section 11.162; 15 16 (3) educator certification and contract requirements under Chapter 21; 17 18 (4) state curriculum and graduation requirements adopted under Chapter 28; and 19 (5) [(4)] academic and financial accountability and 20 21 sanctions under Chapters 39 and 39A. 22 SECTION 2. Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, as amended 23 by this Act, applies to each local innovation plan adopted under Chapter 12A, Education Code, regardless of whether the plan was 24

1 adopted before, on, or after the effective date of this Act. A
2 local innovation plan adopted or renewed before the effective date
3 of this Act must comply with Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, as
4 amended by this Act, not later than September 1, 2025.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
