BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 37.011(f), Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (f) A juvenile justice alternative education program must provide [operate] at least 43,200 minutes of instructional time 8 [seven hours per day and 180 days] per year, except that a program 9 may apply to the Texas Juvenile Justice Department for a waiver of 10 the instructional time [180-day] requirement. The department may 11 12 not grant a waiver to a program under this subsection for a number 13 of minutes [days] that exceeds the highest number of instructional minutes [days] waived by the commissioner during the same school 14 15 year for any [a] school district served by the program.

SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
