5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 28.0121 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 28.0121. FIREARMS SAFETY ELECTIVE COURSE. (a) A
8	school district or open-enrollment charter school that offers a
9	high school program may offer to students in high school an elective
10	course on firearms safety based on the curriculum guidelines
11	developed under Subsection (b). The course must meet the
12	requirements for a one-half elective credit under Section 28.025.
13	(b) The State Board of Education shall develop curriculum
14	guidelines for the elective course on firearms safety. The
15	curriculum guidelines must:
16	(1) focus on accident prevention;
17	(2) promote the safety and protection of students;
18	(3) emphasize how students should respond when
19	encountering a firearm; and
20	(4) include the information contained in the firearms
21	safety portion of a hunter education course under Section 62.014,
22	Parks and Wildlife Code.
23	(c) The State Board of Education shall develop a virtual
24	course on firearms safety that meets the requirements of an

No. 2976 elective course under Subsection (a) for a school district or 1 open-enrollment charter school to offer to high school students. 2 (d) The State Board of Education shall make the virtual 3 course on firearms safety developed under Subsection (c) available 4 5 to: 6 (1) the agency; 7 (2) the Parks and Wildlife Department; and 8 (3) the Department of Public Safety. 9 (e) Each entity described by Subsection (d) shall make the virtual course on firearms safety available to the public free of 10 charge through the entity's Internet website. 11 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 12 of this Act, the State Board of Education shall: 13 14 (1)develop the curriculum guidelines required under 15 Section 28.0121(b), Education Code, as added by this Act; and (2) develop the virtual course on firearms safety 16 17 required under Section 28.0121(c), Education Code, as added by this 18 Act. SECTION 3. Section 28.0121, Education Code, as added by 19 this Act, applies beginning with the 2024-2025 school year. 20 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 25
