- 5 SECTION 1. Section 548.051, Transportation Code, is amended 6 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A motor vehicle that uses electricity as its only source
- 8 of motor power and that is not equipped with an internal combustion
- 9 engine is exempt from the inspection requirements relating to the
- 10 <u>emissions</u> and exhaust systems provided in Subsections
- 11 (a) (12) (15).

- 12 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 13 of this Act, the public safety director of the Department of Public
- 14 Safety shall adopt or amend department rules as necessary to
- 15 implement the provisions of this Act.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 17 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 18 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 19 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 20 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 21 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 22 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
