- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 255.003, Election Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 255.003. UNLAWFUL USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS BY EMPLOYEE OR
- 8 OFFICER OF POLITICAL SUBDIVISION [FOR POLITICAL ADVERTISING].
- 9 SECTION 2. Sections 255.003(a) and (c), Election Code, are
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) An officer or employee of a political subdivision may
- 12 not knowingly spend or authorize the spending of public funds for:
- 13 <u>(1)</u> political advertising; or
- 14 (2) a communication relating to a measure submitted at
- 15 an election as a result of an official action adopted or approved by
- 16 the political subdivision, other than notice required under Chapter
- 17 <u>4</u>.
- (c) A person who violates Subsection (a) $[\frac{\text{or } (b-1)}{\text{or }}]$ commits
- 19 an offense. An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- SECTION 3. Sections 255.003(b) and (b-1), Election Code,
- 21 are repealed.
- 22 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to the use of public funds or resources that occurs on or after the
- 24 effective date of this Act. The use of public funds or resources

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- 1 that occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 2 law in effect before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 3 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
