4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 621.101(b-1), Transportation Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

7 (b-1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a vehicle or combination of vehicles that is powered by an engine 8 9 fueled primarily or secondarily by natural gas or liquefied petroleum gas may exceed any weight limitation under this section 10 11 by an amount that is equal to the difference between the weight of 12 the vehicle attributable to the natural gas or liquefied petroleum gas tank and fueling system carried by that vehicle and the weight 13 14 of a comparable diesel tank and fueling system, provided that the maximum gross weight of the vehicle or combination of vehicles may 15 not exceed 81,000 [82,000] pounds. 16
