4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 801, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 801.2052 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 801.2052. DISMISSAL OF BASELESS OR UNFOUNDED
8	COMPLAINT. (a) If the board determines that a complaint filed with
9	the board is baseless or unfounded, the board shall:
10	(1) dismiss the complaint; and
11	(2) include a statement in the record of the complaint
12	that the complaint was dismissed because the complaint was baseless
13	or unfounded.
14	(b) The board shall adopt rules that establish criteria for
15	determining that a complaint is baseless or unfounded.
16	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
