- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 442.0083(e), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) A grant for a historic courthouse project may not exceed the greater of \$10 million [\$6 million] or two percent of the amount 8 appropriated for implementing the historic courthouse preservation
- program during the state fiscal biennium. 10

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- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 442, Government Code, is 12 amended by adding Section 442.0151 to read as follows:
- Sec. 442.0151. HISTORIC INFRASTRUCTURE SUSTAINABILITY 13
- fund is created as a trust fund outside the treasury held by the 15

TRUST FUND. (a) The historic infrastructure sustainability trust

- 16 Texas Treasury Safekeeping Trust Company and administered by the
- comptroller as trustee on behalf of the people of this state to
- generate earnings on money in the fund for the purpose of 18
- maintaining, preserving, rehabilitating, and restoring historic 19
- sites throughout the state. In this section, "trust company" means 20
- 21 the Texas Treasury Safekeeping Trust Company, and "commission"
- means the Texas Historical Commission. 22
- 23 (b) The fund consists of:
- 24 (1) money appropriated or transferred to the fund at

- 1 the direction of the legislature;
- 2 (2) gifts, grants, and donations received by the
- 3 commission for a purpose for which money in the fund may be used
- 4 under this section; and
- 5 (3) the returns received from investment of money in
- 6 the fund.
- 7 (b) The trust company shall hold, manage, and invest the
- 8 fund. The trust company shall determine the amount available for
- 9 distribution from the fund determined in accordance with a
- 10 distribution policy that is adopted by the comptroller and designed
- 11 to preserve the purchasing power of the fund's assets, provide a
- 12 stable and predictable stream of annual distributions, and meet
- 13 liquidity needs of the fund as appropriate. The expenses of
- 14 managing the fund and its assets shall be paid from the fund.
- 15 Except as provided by this section, money in the fund may not be
- 16 used for any other purpose.
- 17 <u>(c) In managing the assets of the fund, through procedures</u>
- 18 and subject to restrictions the trust company considers
- 19 appropriate, the trust company may acquire, exchange, sell,
- 20 <u>supervise</u>, manage, or retain any kind of investment that a prudent
- 21 <u>investor</u>, exercising reasonable care, skill, and caution, would
- 22 acquire or retain in light of the purposes, terms, distribution
- 23 requirements, liquidity requirements, and other circumstances of
- 24 the fund then prevailing, taking into consideration the investment
- 25 of all the assets of the fund rather than a single investment. The
- 26 commission will provide the trust company with a cash flow forecast
- 27 at least annually, and more frequently as appropriate, for purposes

- 1 of distribution and liquidity requirements.
- 2 (d) The commission may request an annual fund distribution
- 3 not to exceed the amount the trust company determines available for
- 4 distribution as provided under subsection (b). The amount
- 5 distributed may only be used for the purpose of maintaining,
- 6 preserving, rehabilitating, and restoring state historic sites
- 7 under the control of the commission and for the historic courthouse
- 8 preservation program under Section 442.0081. The commission shall
- 9 spend at least one-third of the funds distributed on the historic
- 10 courthouse preservation program. Money in the fund may not be used
- 11 to pay salaries, employee benefits, costs associated with employee
- 12 benefits, or administration, operating, or program costs of the
- 13 commission.
- (e) Subject to subsection (f), not more frequently than once
- 15 per calendar year, the commission may request an additional
- 16 <u>distribution from the fund in excess of the amount the trust company</u>
- 17 determines is available for distribution under the terms of
- 18 subsection (b), to be used for the purposes described in subsection
- 19 (d). The amount requested pursuant to this subsection shall not
- 20 exceed the amount distributed to the commission pursuant to the
- 21 comptroller's policy in the preceding calendar year.
- 22 (f) The commission may approve a distribution of the fund
- 23 authorized under Subsection (e) after the commission certifies to
- 24 the Legislative Budget Board that:
- 25 (1) the commission has reviewed and approved the use of the
- 26 money;
- 27 (2) all purchases made with the money will conform to any

- 1 applicable provision of law governing state procurement and
- 2 contracting; and
- 3 (3) the money will not be used to:
- 4 (A) pay salaries, employee benefits, costs associated with
- 5 employee benefits, or administration, operating or program costs of
- 6 the commission or the buildings or grounds subject to its
- 7 authority;
- 8 (B) acquire new historic sites or real property; or
- 9 (C) purchase capital equipment that is not related to the
- 10 rehabilitation or restoration of a building or grounds.
- 11 (g) All expenditures by the commission under this section
- 12 are subject to audit by the state auditor.
- (h) The commission shall include in the strategic plan
- 14 submitted under Section 2056.002 a report on each project funded
- 15 using money in the fund during the two-year period preceding the
- 16 date on which the commission submits the plan and a list of each
- 17 project the commission anticipates will be funded using money in
- 18 the fund for the period covered by the plan.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 442.073, Government Code, is amended by
- 20 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 21 follows:
- 22 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), money [Money] in
- 23 the account may be used only to administer, operate, preserve,
- 24 repair, expand, or otherwise maintain a historic site or to acquire
- 25 a historical item appropriate to a historic site.
- 26 (e) The commission may make an expenditure from the account
- 27 for a historic site that is not described by Section 442.072(a).

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- 1 The commission shall provide notice of an expenditure described by
- 2 this subsection to the Legislative Budget Board not later than the
- 3 30th day after the date the commission makes the expenditure. The
- 4 Legislative Budget Board may establish the procedure by which the
- 5 commission provides notice to the board under this subsection.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
