## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

⊥	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the determination of the best interest of a child in
- 3 certain suits affecting the parent-child relationship.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 153.002, Family Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 Sec. 153.002. BEST INTEREST OF CHILD. (a) The best
- 8 interest of the child shall always be the primary consideration of
- 9 the court in determining the issues of conservatorship and
- 10 possession of and access to the child.
- 11 (b) In a suit between a parent and a non-parent, it is a
- 12 <u>rebuttable presumption that:</u>
- 13 (1) a parent acts in the best interest of the parent's
- 14 child; and
- 15 (2) it is in the best interest of a child to be in the
- 16 care, custody and control of a parent.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 156.101, Family Code, is amended by
- 18 adding a new Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 19 (c) In a suit to which this chapter applies between a parent
- 20 and a nonparent, the presumption in Section 153.002(b) applies
- 21 unless the presumption has been overcome in the most recent final
- 22 order regarding the child who is the subject of the suit. The
- 23 presumption shall be deemed to have been overcome as to a given
- 24 parent if, in a prior proceeding and with respect to a child who is

- 1 the subject of the suit:
- 2 (1) the order sought to be modified expressly stated
- 3 that the presumption was overcome on the issue currently before the
- 4 court;
- 5 (2) the parent was neither named as nor continued as a
- 6 managing conservator in the most recent final order and the parent
- 7 is not being named as a managing conservator in the final order in
- 8 the current case before the court; or
- 9 (3) the order sought to be modified resulted from the
- 10 parent's voluntary relinquishment of actual care, custody,
- 11 control, and possession of the child to a nonparent.
- 12 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to an
- 13 action that is pending on or filed on or after the effective date of
- 14 this Act.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
