A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the operation of load management programs
3 transmission and distribution utilities.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 38.075(e), Utilities Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle, the commission shall allow a transmission and distribution utility 8 9 to design and operate one or more [a] load management programs [program for nonresidential customers] to be used where the 10 11 independent organization certified under Section 39.151 for the ERCOT power region has declared a Level 2 Emergency or a higher 12 level of emergency or has otherwise directed the transmission and 13 14 distribution utility to shed load. A load management program operated under this subsection must include only customers who have 15 agreed in writing to participate. A transmission and distribution 16 utility <u>operating</u> [implementing] a load management program under 17 this subsection shall be permitted to recover the reasonable and 18 necessary costs of the load management program under Chapter 36. A 19 load management program operated under this subsection is not 20 21 considered a competitive service.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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H.B. No. 30951 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this2 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
