- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1431.015(b), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or a
- 8 rating requirement prescribed by Chapter 1371, an issuer located
- 9 within 70 miles of the Gulf of Mexico or of a bay or inlet of the
- 10 gulf may authorize the issuance of an anticipation note or other
- 11 obligation in the event of an emergency. An anticipation note or
- 12 other obligation issued under this section is an obligation under
- 13 Chapter 1371, but is not required to be rated as required by that
- 14 chapter.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an anticipation note or obligation issued on or after the
- 17 effective date of this Act. A note or obligation issued before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 19 date the note or obligation was issued, and that law is continued in
- 20 effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
