8	SECTION 1. Section 552.138(a), Government Code, is amended

- by adding Subdivision (1-a) to read as follows: 9
- (1-a) "License" means a license, certificate, 10
- registration, permit, or other authorization that: 11
- 12 (A) is issued by a governmental body; and
- 13 (B) a person must obtain to practice or engage in
- 14 a particular business, occupation, or profession.
- SECTION 2. Section 552.138, Government Code, is amended by 15
- adding Subsections (f) and (g) to read as follows: 16
- (f) Notwithstanding any other law, a governmental body may 17
- not sell or otherwise release the name, home or business address, 18
- place of employment, telephone number, electronic mail address, 19
- social security number, date of birth, driver's license or state 20
- identification number, passport number, emergency contact 21
- information, or numeric identifier of a person who: 22
- 23 (1) holds, previously held, or is an applicant for a
- 24 license issued by the governmental body; and

- 1 (2) notifies the governmental body on a form provided
- 2 by the office of the attorney general or the governmental body that
- 3 the person:
- 4 (A) is a current or former client of a family
- 5 violence shelter center, victims of trafficking shelter center, or
- 6 sexual assault program or is a survivor of family violence,
- 7 <u>domestic violence</u>, or sexual assault; and
- 8 (B) chooses to restrict public access to the
- 9 information.
- 10 (g) A governmental body may redact information described by
- 11 Subsection (f) from a response to a request for a list or directory
- 12 of license holders, former license holders, or license applicants
- 13 without the necessity of requesting a decision from the attorney
- 14 general under Subchapter G.
- 15 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 16 of this Act, the office of the attorney general shall prepare the
- 17 form described by Section 552.138(f)(2), Government Code, as added
- 18 by this Act, make the form available on the attorney general's
- 19 website, and notify family violence shelter centers, victims of
- 20 trafficking shelter centers, and sexual assault programs of the
- 21 availability and purpose of the form.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
