- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2054.353(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The department shall administer a common electronic
- 9 system using the Internet through which a licensing entity can
- 10 electronically:
- 11 (1) send occupational licenses and other documents to
- 12 persons regulated by the licensing entity and to the public;
- 13 (2) receive applications for occupational licenses
- 14 and other documents for filing from persons regulated by the
- 15 licensing entity and from the public, including documents that can
- 16 be electronically signed if necessary; [and]
- 17 (3) receive required payments from persons regulated
- 18 by the licensing entity and from the public; and
- 19 (4) track the status of a license holder or applicant,
- 20 including disciplinary information, in a manner that is not
- 21 accessible to the public.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 2054.353(d), Government Code, is
- 23 repealed.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
