A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to eligibility requirements for the Teach for Texas Loan
- 3 Repayment Assistance Program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 56.352(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The purpose of this subchapter is to attract to the:
- 8 <u>(1)</u> teaching profession <u>any</u> persons who have expressed
- 9 interest in teaching and to support the employment of those persons
- 10 as classroom teachers by providing student loan repayment
- 11 assistance for service as a classroom teacher in the public schools
- 12 of this state; and
- 13 (2) school mental health profession any persons who
- 14 have expressed interest in providing mental health services to
- 15 students enrolled in public schools and to support the employment
- of those persons as school mental health professionals by providing
- 17 student loan repayment assistance for service as a mental health
- 18 provider in the public schools of this state.
- 19 SECTION 2. Sections 56.353(a) and (c), Education Code, are
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) Teach for Texas repayment assistance is available only
- 22 to a person who applies for the assistance and who:
- 23 (1) is certified in a teaching field identified by the
- 24 commissioner of education as experiencing a critical shortage of

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- 1 teachers in this state in the year in which the person receives the
- 2 assistance and has for at least one year taught full-time at, and is
- 3 currently teaching full-time at, the preschool, primary, or
- 4 secondary level in a public school in this state in that teaching
- 5 field; [or]
- 6 (2) is a certified educator who has for at least one
- 7 year taught full-time at, and is currently teaching full-time at,
- 8 the preschool, primary, or secondary level in a public school in
- 9 this state in a community identified by the commissioner of
- 10 education as experiencing a critical shortage of teachers in the
- 11 year in which the person receives the assistance; or
- 12 (3) is a mental health professional who:
- (A) for at least one year has been employed
- 14 <u>full-time</u> at, and provided mental health services to students
- 15 <u>enrolled in, a public school in this state; and</u>
- 16 (B) is currently employed and providing mental
- 17 health services as described by Paragraph (A).
- 18 (c) If the money available for loan repayment assistance in
- 19 a period for which assistance is awarded is insufficient to provide
- 20 assistance to all eligible applicants described by Subsection (b),
- 21 the coordinating board shall establish priorities for awarding
- 22 repayment assistance to address only the most critical teacher
- 23 shortages described by Subsection (a)(1) or (2) [(a)].
- SECTION 3. Section 56.355(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 25 read as follows:
- 26 (a) The coordinating board may determine the manner in which
- 27 Teach for Texas loan repayment assistance is to be paid. The

- 1 coordinating board may provide for the payment of a portion of the
- 2 repayment assistance in one or more installments before the person
- 3 completes a full year of service as a teacher or a school mental
- 4 health professional, as applicable, and for the payment of the
- 5 remainder of the repayment assistance for that year after the
- 6 completion of the full year of service.
- 7 SECTION 4. Section 56.3575(b), Education Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (b) The coordinating board shall distribute a copy of the
- 10 rules adopted under this section and pertinent information relating
- 11 to this subchapter to each public or private institution of higher
- 12 education in this state that offers:
- 13 (1) an educator certification program, including an
- 14 alternative educator certification program or another equivalent
- 15 program; or
- 16 (2) an educational program that prepares students for
- 17 a school mental health profession.
- 18 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 19 56.353, Education Code, applies only to a person who first
- 20 establishes eligibility for loan repayment assistance under
- 21 Subchapter O, Chapter 56, Education Code, as amended by this Act, on
- 22 the basis of an application submitted on or after September 1, 2023.
- 23 A person who first establishes eligibility on the basis of an
- 24 application submitted before September 1, 2023, is governed by the
- 25 law in effect on the date the application was submitted, and the
- 26 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
