A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authority to arrest a person without a warrant. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Citizens' Civil 4 5 Liberties Act. SECTION 2. Article 14.01, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 6 amended to read as follows: 7 Art. 14.01. OFFENSE WITHIN VIEW. (a) 8 A person who is a commissioned or noncommissioned security officer licensed under 9 Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, and is engaged in the performance 10 11 of the person's duties as a security officer [peace officer or any 12 other person,] may, without a warrant, arrest an offender when the offense is committed in the person's [his] presence or within the 13 14 person's [his] view, if the offense is one classed as a felony or as an offense against the public peace. 15 A peace officer may arrest an offender without a warrant 16 (b) for any offense committed in the peace officer's [his] presence or 17 within the peace officer's [his] view. 18 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
