- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Human Resources Code,
- is amended by adding Section 42.0563 to read as follows: 6
- 7 Sec. 42.0563. PRE-EMPLOYMENT AFFIDAVIT. (a) An applicant
- for a position with a child-care facility must submit, using a form 8
- 9 adopted by the department, a pre-employment affidavit disclosing
- whether the applicant has ever been charged with, adjudicated for, 10
- or convicted of having an inappropriate relationship with a minor. 11
- 12 (b) An applicant who answers affirmatively concerning an
- inappropriate relationship with a minor must disclose in the 13
- 14 affidavit all relevant facts pertaining to the charge,
- adjudication, or conviction, including, for a charge, whether the 15
- 16 charge was determined to be true or false.
- (c) An applicant is not precluded from being employed based 17
- on a disclosed charge if the employing entity determines based on 18
- the information disclosed in the affidavit that the charge was 19
- 20 false.

- 21 (d) A determination that an employee failed to disclose
- information required to be disclosed by an applicant under this 22
- 23 section is grounds for termination of employment.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
