H.B. No. 3224

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the status of the registration of a vehicle after a 3 failure to establish financial responsibility. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter H, Chapter 601, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 SUBCHAPTER H. FAILURE TO MAINTAIN EVIDENCE OF FINANCIAL 7 RESPONSIBILITY; SUSPENSION OF DRIVER'S LICENSE [AND MOTOR VEHICLE 8 REGISTRATION] 9 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 601.231, Transportation 10 11 Code, is amended to read as follows: 12 Sec. 601.231. SUSPENSION OF DRIVER'S LICENSE [AND VEHICLE 13 RECISTRATION]. 14 SECTION 3. Section 601.231(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 15 If a person is convicted of an offense under Section 16 (a) 601.191 and a prior conviction of that person under that section has 17 been reported to the department by a magistrate or the judge or 18 clerk of a court, the department shall suspend the driver's license 19 20 [and vehicle registrations] of the person unless the person files 21 and maintains evidence of financial responsibility with the department until the second anniversary of the date of the 22 23 subsequent conviction. SECTION 4. Section 601.232, Transportation Code, is amended 24

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1 to read as follows:

2 Sec. 601.232. NOTICE OF SUSPENSION. (a) The department 3 shall send in a timely manner a notice to each person whose driver's 4 license <u>is</u> [and vehicle registrations are] suspended under Section 5 601.231.

6 (b) The notice must state that the person's driver's license 7 <u>is</u> [and registration are] suspended and that the person may apply 8 for reinstatement of the license [and vehicle registration] or 9 issuance of a new license [and registration] as provided by 10 Sections 601.162 and 601.376.

SECTION 5. Section 601.233(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

13 (a) A citation for an offense under Section 601.191 issued 14 as a result of Section 601.053 must include, in type larger than 15 other type on the citation, the following statement:

"A second or subsequent conviction of an offense under the Texas 16 17 Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act will result in the [and motor vehicle suspension of your driver's license 18 registration] unless you file and maintain evidence of financial 19 responsibility with the Department of Public Safety for two years 20 21 from the date of conviction. The department may waive the requirement to file evidence of financial responsibility if you 22 23 file satisfactory evidence with the department showing that at the 24 time this citation was issued, the vehicle was covered by a motor vehicle liability insurance policy or that you were otherwise 25 26 exempt from the requirements to provide evidence of financial responsibility." 27

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SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act applies only 1 to a vehicle registration suspended for an offense committed on or 2 after the effective date of this Act. A vehicle registration 3 4 suspended for an offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was 5 6 committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed 7 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense 8 occurred before that date. 9

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SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
