3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 87.013, Local Government Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 87.013. GENERAL GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL. (a) An officer
7	may be removed for:

- 8 (1) incompetency;
- 9 (2) official misconduct; or
- 10 (3) intoxication, as defined by Section 49.01(2) of
 11 the Penal Code, on or off duty caused by drinking an alcoholic
- 12 beverage.
- 13 (b) Intoxication is not a ground for removal if it appears 14 at the trial that the intoxication was caused by drinking an 15 alcoholic beverage on the direction and prescription of a licensed 16 physician practicing in this state.
- SECTION 2. This act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
