## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to the seizure of firearms during the emergency detention 2 of certain persons who may have a mental illness. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 573.001(h), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 7 (h) A peace officer who takes a person into custody under Subsection (a) shall [may] immediately seize any firearm found in 8 possession of the person. After seizing a firearm under this 9 subsection, the peace officer shall comply with the requirements of 10 Article 18.191, Code of Criminal Procedure. 11 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 13 to an apprehension for an emergency detention that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. An apprehension for emergency 14 detention that occurs before the effective date of this Act is 15 governed by the law in effect on the date the apprehension for 16 emergency detention occurred, and the former law is continued in 17 effect for that purpose. 18 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
