A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the manufacture, transportation, storage, and disposa

- 2 relating to the manufacture, transportation, storage, and disposal
 3 of new and scrap tires; authorizing a fee.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 361.112, Health and
- 6 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 361.112. STORAGE, TRANSPORTATION, AND DISPOSAL OF USED
- 8 OR SCRAP TIRES; MANUFACTURER TIRE IDENTIFICATION INFORMATION.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 361.112, Health and Safety Code, is
- amended by adding Subsections (g-1), (g-2), (g-3), (g-4), (n), (o),
- 11 and (p) to read as follows:

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- 12 <u>(g-1)</u> Not later than one month after the date a tire is
- 13 manufactured in this state, the manufacturer shall submit to the
- 14 commission information that uniquely identifies the tire. The
- 15 manufacturer may submit the information on a date later than one
- 16 month after the tire manufacture date if the manufacturer requests
- 17 <u>a later submission date that is approved by the commission.</u>
- 18 <u>(g-2)</u> A transporter of scrap tires or a storage site or
- 19 <u>disposal and storage facility for scrap tires shall electronically</u>
- 20 sign and submit a manifest prepared under this section to the
- 21 commission on the initial transfer of each shipment of scrap tires
- 22 to the transporter, site, or facility.
- 23 <u>(g-3)</u> The commission by rule shall prescribe requirements
- 24 for a scrap tire tagging system. A manifest prepared and submitted

- 1 under this section must include a reference to the tagging system
- 2 and uniquely identify each tire received from a transporter of
- 3 scrap tires.
- 4 (g-4) A transporter of scrap tires is liable for each scrap
- 5 tire transported to a storage site or disposal facility that is not
- 6 registered or permitted under this section. The commissioners
- 7 court of the county in which the improper storage or disposal of the
- 8 scrap tire occurs may impose a fine on the transporter in an amount
- 9 not to exceed \$500 per tire.
- 10 (n) The commissioners court of a county in which is located
- 11 a generator of scrap tires who uses an unregistered transporter to
- 12 transport tires may:
- 13 (1) impose a fine in an amount not to exceed \$500 on
- 14 the generator for each scrap tire the unregistered transporter
- 15 transports; or
- 16 (2) suspend or revoke any license or permit to sell
- 17 tires the county has issued to the generator.
- 18 <u>(o) The commissioners court of a county may:</u>
- 19 (1) impose a fee of not more than \$5 for each tire
- 20 disposal in the county; and
- 21 (2) transfer 50 cents of the fee imposed under
- 22 <u>Subdivision (1) to the commission.</u>
- 23 <u>(p) The commissioners court of a county:</u>
- 24 (1) shall deposit a fine or fee collected under this
- 25 section into an account administered by the county for the purpose
- 26 of disposing of, mitigating the effects from disposal of, and
- 27 recyc<u>ling tires; and</u>

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- 1 (2) may use any fines or fees collected under this
- 2 <u>section to establish a tire recycling facility in the county.</u>
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
