Section 361.112, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subsections (g-1), (g-2), (g-3), (g-4), (n), (o), 10 11 and (p) to read as follows: (g-1) Not later than one month after the date a tire is 12 manufactured in this state, the manufacturer shall submit to the 13 14 commission information that uniquely identifies the tire. The manufacturer may submit the information on a date later than one 15 16 month after the tire manufacture date if the manufacturer requests a later submission date that is approved by the commission. 17 (g-2) A transporter of scrap tires or a storage site or 18 disposal and storage facility for scrap tires shall electronically 19 sign and submit a manifest prepared under this section to the 20 commission on the initial transfer of each shipment of scrap tires 21 to the transporter, site, or facility. 22 23 (g-3) The commission by rule shall prescribe requirements 24 for a scrap tire tagging system.
