2	relating to the release of a balloon; providing a criminal penalty.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 365, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 365.018 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 365.018. RELEASE OF BALLOON; CRIMINAL PENALTY. (a) In
7	this section, "balloon" means a bag of rubber, latex, Mylar, or
8	similar material inflated with lighter-than-air gas.
9	(b) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly
10	releases a balloon into the air outside a roofed structure.
11	(c) A person commits an offense if:
12	(1) the person organizes, sponsors, or promotes an
13	event knowing that the release of a balloon into the air outside a
14	roofed structure is an authorized part of the event; and
15	(2) at the event, a balloon is released into the air
16	outside a roofed structure.
17	(d) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that:
18	(1) the balloon was released for a meteorological or
19	scientific purpose and that the release was made or authorized by a
20	federal, state, or local governmental entity; or
21	(2) the balloon released was inflated with heated air
22	and designed for recovery after launching.
23	(e) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
24	(f) This section does not affect the authority of a

- 1 municipality to adopt or enforce an ordinance regarding the release
- 2 <u>of a balloon.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
