1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the dissolution of the Green Tree Park Municipal  
1-20 Utility District.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. (a) The directors of the Green Tree Park  
1-23 Municipal Utility District shall wind up the affairs of the  
1-24 district, including the filing of any dissolution documents with  
1-25 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

1-26 (b) On the 60th day after the effective date of this Act:

1-27 (1) the Green Tree Park Municipal Utility District is  
1-28 dissolved; and

1-29 (2) the terms of the directors of the district expire.

1-30 SECTION 2. Effective on the 61st day after the effective  
1-31 date of this Act, Chapter 7889, Special District Local Laws Code, is  
1-32 repealed.

1-33 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to  
1-34 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this  
1-35 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a  
1-36 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,  
1-37 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished  
1-38 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,  
1-39 Government Code.

1-40 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has  
1-41 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on  
1-42 Environmental Quality.

1-43 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed  
1-44 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the  
1-45 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of  
1-46 representatives within the required time.

1-47 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this  
1-48 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect  
1-49 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled  
1-50 and accomplished.

1-51 SECTION 4. Except as provided by Section 2 of this Act, this  
1-52 Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of  
1-53 all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39,  
1-54 Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the  
1-55 vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect  
1-56 September 1, 2023.
