## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study by the Texas Education Agency on the
- 3 administration of assessment instruments in Spanish to certain
- 4 public school students in grades six through 12.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 39.02303 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 39.02303. STUDY ON ADMINISTRATION OF CERTAIN
- 9 ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENTS IN SPANISH. (a) In this section, "emergent
- 10 bilingual student" has the meaning assigned by Section 29.052.
- 11 (b) The agency shall conduct a study regarding the
- 12 <u>feasibility of administering assessment instruments adopted under</u>
- 13 Section 39.023 and administered to students in grades six through
- 14 12 in Spanish for emergent bilingual students whose primary
- 15 language is Spanish.
- 16 (c) The study must include research regarding how to
- 17 administer the assessment instrument in a manner that allows, to
- 18 the extent practicable, the score an emergent bilingual student
- 19 receives on the assessment instrument to be statistically useful
- 20 for comparison, considering the limited number of emergent
- 21 bilingual students, to performance by students administered the
- 22 same instrument in English.
- 23 (d) Not later than December 1, 2024, the agency shall
- 24 prepare and submit to the legislature a report on the results of the

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- 1 study and any recommendations for legislative or other action.
- 2 <u>(e) This section expires September 1, 2025.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
