## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a school district's grievance procedure regarding
3	complaints concerning violation of parental rights.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 26.011, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (c), (d), and (e) to read as follows:
7	(c) The grievance procedure adopted under Subsection (a)
8	must:
9	(1) provide for:
10	(A) a parent's complaint to be filed in writing
11	with the principal of the campus at which the parent's student is
12	<pre>enrolled;</pre>
13	(B) if the principal does not grant the requested
14	relief, an appeal on written request to the district superintendent
15	or the superintendent's designee that includes a review of all
16	documents considered by the principal;
17	(C) if the superintendent or the
18	superintendent's designee does not grant the requested relief, an
19	appeal on written request to the board of trustees of the district
20	that includes a review of all documents considered by the principal
21	and the superintendent or the superintendent's designee; and
22	(D) if the board of trustees of the district does
23	not grant the requested relief, notice to the parent regarding the
24	parent's right to file an appeal with the commissioner under

- 1 Section 7.057; and
- 2 (2) be:
- 3 (A) posted in a prominent location on the
- 4 district's Internet website, along with instructions on how a
- 5 parent may file a complaint; and
- 6 (B) provided to the parent of each student
- 7 enrolled in the district at the beginning of each school year and on
- 8 request.
- 9 (d) The agency shall:
- 10 (1) adopt a model grievance procedure for use by
- 11 school districts under this section; and
- 12 (2) post on the agency's Internet website a copy of the
- 13 model grievance policy and general guidelines regarding how a
- 14 parent may file a complaint with a school district under this
- 15 section or appeal a district's decision to the commissioner under
- 16 Section 7.057.
- 17 (e) A grievance procedure adopted under this section may not
- 18 require a parent to file a complaint within a specified period of
- 19 time.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
