20	contribution in excess of the political contribution amount:
21	(A) report as a political contribution the full
22	amount, not including the amount paid in excess of the political
23	contribution amount; and
24	(B) report as an in-kind contribution the amount

paid in excess of the political contribution amount. 1 2 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter and for purposes of reporting in-kind contributions under Subsection 3 4 (a)(2)(B), a candidate or officeholder may aggregate those in-kind contributions for the reporting period during which the in-kind 5 6 contributions are accepted. 7 SECTION 2. Section 254.044, Election Code, as added by this 8 Act, applies only to a report of political contributions and

9 expenditures under Chapter 254, Election Code, that is required to 10 be filed on or after January 1, 2024.
