(a) A candidate or 8 9 officeholder who accepts a political contribution made using a credit card shall: 10 11 (1) for a political contribution for which a 12 processing fee is deducted by the credit card issuer from the 13 political contribution amount: 14 (A) report as a political contribution the full amount, including the deducted amount; and 15 (B) report as a political expenditure the 16 17 deducted amount; and 18 (2) for a political contribution for which a processing fee is paid by the person making the political 19 contribution in excess of the political contribution amount: 20 21 (A) report as a political contribution the full 22 amount, not including the amount paid in excess of the political 23 contribution amount; and (B) report as an in-kind contribution the amount 24

paid in excess of the political contribution amount. 1 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter and 2 for purposes of reporting in-kind contributions under Subsection 3 4 (a)(2)(B), a candidate or officeholder may aggregate those in-kind contributions for the reporting period during which the in-kind 5 6 contributions are accepted. 7 SECTION 2. Section 254.044, Election Code, as added by this 8 Act, applies only to a report of political contributions and

9 expenditures under Chapter 254, Election Code, that is required to 10 be filed on or after January 1, 2024.
