5	SECTION 1. Chapter 493, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 493.035 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 493.035. ACCESS TO COMMUNICATION SERVICES FOR
8	OFFENDERS. (a) In this section, "offender" means an inmate or
9	state jail defendant confined in a facility operated by or under
10	contract with the department.
11	(b) The department shall adopt a policy regarding access by
12	offenders to communication services. The policy:
13	(1) must allow an offender to make domestic telephone
14	calls with a duration of up to 30 minutes per call to persons on the
15	offender's approved calling list at no cost to the offender or the
16	person receiving the call;
17	(2) may not limit the total number of telephone calls
18	that are at no cost under Subdivision (1); and
19	(3) if the offender is eligible for remote video
20	visitation, must provide that the visit is at no cost to the
21	offender or the person visiting the offender.
22	SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2023, the Texas
23	Department of Criminal Justice shall adopt the policy required by
24	Section 493.035, Government Code, as added by this Act.
