## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to establishing the oyster council of the Parks and
- 3 Wildlife Department.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 76, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subchapter D to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER D. OYSTER COUNCIL
- 8 Sec. 76.201. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "council"
- 9 means the oyster council established under this subchapter.
- Sec. 76.202. ESTABLISHMENT AND PURPOSE. (a) The oyster
- 11 council is established to advise the commission, director, and
- 12 <u>department on the taking of oysters in this state.</u>
- (b) Chapter 2110, Government Code, does not apply to the
- 14 council.
- Sec. 76.203. COMPOSITION. The council is composed of 13
- 16 members appointed by the commission, each of whom must:
- 17 (1) hold a commercial oyster fisherman's license; or
- 18 (2) be nominated by the holder of a commercial oyster
- 19 fisherman's license.
- Sec. 76.204. TERMS; VACANCY. (a) Council members serve
- 21 staggered six-year terms, with the terms of four or five members
- 22 expiring on January 1 of each even-numbered year.
- 23 (b) A vacancy on the council shall be filled in the same
- 24 manner as the original appointment.

- 1 Sec. 76.205. REMOVAL FROM COUNCIL. The commission may
- 2 remove a council member if the member has been absent from three or
- 3 more council meetings scheduled within the preceding 12 months,
- 4 unless the absences are excused. The commission shall post notice
- 5 of the removal on the commission's Internet website.
- 6 Sec. 76.206. OFFICERS. The council shall elect from the
- 7 <u>council's membership a presiding officer and assistant presiding</u>
- 8 officer.
- 9 Sec. 76.207. MEETINGS. (a) The council on its own
- 10 initiative may meet at any time to discuss any council business,
- 11 including restrictions on the taking of oysters.
- 12 (b) The council shall:
- 13 (1) notify the commission not later than the 11th day
- 14 before the date of a council meeting; and
- 15 (2) not later than the seventh day before the date of a
- 16 council meeting, post notice of the meeting on the department's
- 17 Internet website.
- 18 (c) Except for a closed meeting authorized by Subchapter D,
- 19 Chapter 551, Government Code, a council meeting is open to the
- 20 public.
- 21 (d) Notice of a council meeting must be given as provided by
- 22 Chapter 551, Government Code.
- (e) A council meeting shall be held at a location determined
- 24 by the council.
- 25 (f) The council shall:
- 26 (1) broadcast live on the department's Internet
- 27 website all council meetings, other than closed meetings; and

- 1 (2) maintain on the department's Internet website an
- 2 archive of council meetings.
- 3 (g) A recording of a council meeting must be maintained in
- 4 the archive required under Subsection (f) through and including the
- 5 second anniversary of the meeting.
- 6 Sec. 76.208. OPEN MEETINGS AND OPEN RECORDS. Except as
- 7 specifically provided by this chapter or another law, the council
- 8 <u>is subject to Chapters 551 and 552, Government Code.</u>
- 9 Sec. 76.209. RESTRICTIONS ON TAKING OF OYSTERS. (a) The
- 10 council must meet if the commission, director, or department
- 11 requests a meeting to discuss imposing a restriction described by
- 12 Section 76.305.
- 13 (b) The council members may make recommendations regarding
- 14 a restriction on the taking of oysters requested under Subsection
- 15 <u>(a)</u>.
- 16 Sec. 76.210. RECOMMENDATIONS FOR OYSTER MANAGEMENT;
- 17 REPORT. (a) The council shall advise the commission and department
- 18 and make recommendations concerning the administrative aspects of
- 19 the taking of oysters.
- 20 (b) Annually, on or before a date established by the
- 21 department before the opening of oyster season, the council shall
- 22 submit to the commission and department a report evaluating the
- 23 taking of oysters in this state.
- Sec. 76.211. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES; RULES. (a) The
- 25 director shall establish administrative procedures to carry out the
- 26 requirements of this subchapter.
- 27 (b) The commission shall adopt any rules necessary for the

- 1 administration of the council established under this subchapter.
- 2 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 76, Parks and Wildlife
- 3 Code, is amended by adding Section 76.305 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 76.305. RESTRICTIONS ON TAKING OF OYSTERS.
- 5 Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, the commission,
- 6 director, and department shall consult with the oyster council in
- 7 <u>accordance with Section 76.209 before:</u>
- 8 (1) closing an area to the taking of oysters;
- 9 (2) closing an open season for the taking of oysters on
- 10 a date earlier than the department's previously published closing
- 11 date for the season; or
- 12 (3) during an open season for the taking of oysters,
- 13 <u>adopting or amending commission rules or department guidelines</u>
- 14 regarding the taking of oysters, including:
- 15 (A) size limits;
- 16 (B) bag limits; and
- 17 (C) limits on the time of day during which the
- 18 taking of oysters is authorized.
- 19 SECTION 3. Sections 76.118(c) and (g), Parks and Wildlife
- 20 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 21 (c) A person who violates Sections 76.109 and [either
- 22 Section 76.115 or ] 76.116 in the same criminal episode commits an
- 23 offense that is a Class A Parks and Wildlife Code misdemeanor.
- 24 (g) If it is shown on the trial of a defendant for a
- 25 violation of Sections [Section] 76.109 and [either Section 76.115
- 26 or 76.116 occurring in the same criminal episode that the
- 27 defendant has been convicted once before within five years before

- 1 the trial date of a violation of <u>Sections</u> [<del>Section</del>] 76.109 and
- 2 [either Section 76.115 or] 76.116 occurring in the same criminal
- 3 episode, the defendant is guilty of a Parks and Wildlife Code
- 4 felony.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 76.115, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 repealed.
- 7 SECTION 5. (a) Not later than December 1, 2023, the Parks
- 8 and Wildlife Commission shall adopt rules and procedures necessary
- 9 to administer the oyster council established under Subchapter D,
- 10 Chapter 76, Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by this Act.
- 11 (b) As soon as practicable after the adoption of rules and
- 12 procedures under Subsection (a) of this section but not later than
- 13 January 1, 2024, the Parks and Wildlife Commission shall appoint
- 14 the initial members of the oyster council established under
- 15 Subchapter D, Chapter 76, Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by this
- 16 Act.
- 17 (c) At the first meeting of the oyster council that follows
- 18 the appointment of the initial council members, the council members
- 19 shall draw lots to determine which four council members will serve
- 20 terms that expire on January 1, 2026, which four council members
- 21 will serve terms that expire on January 1, 2028, and which five
- 22 council members will serve terms that expire on January 1, 2030.
- 23 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
