12	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, for a construction
13	project contracted for an amount that is less than one percent of
14	the total amount of a municipality's most recently adopted budget,
15	the municipality is not required to:
16	(1) ensure that the contractor is covered by workers'
17	compensation insurance coverage; or

- 20 (c) For the purpose of determining the contracted amount of
- 21 <u>a construction project under Subsection (b), a municipality may not</u>
