4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 501, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 501.0237 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 501.0237. ISSUANCE OF TITLE TO DEALER ON DISCHARGE OF
8	LIEN. (a) A dealer who is unable to obtain a title for a motor
9	vehicle from a lienholder after the discharge of a lien under
10	Section 501.115(a) may apply to the department for a title in the
11	dealer's name for resale purposes not earlier than the 20th day
12	after the date the debt or claim secured by the lien is fully paid.
13	(b) An application under Subsection (a) must include:
14	(1) evidence of full payment of the lien in the form of
15	a release of lien, proof of payment, electronic funds transfer, or
16	other sufficient evidence acceptable to the department;
17	(2) evidence of ownership transfer from the previous
18	recorded owner to the dealer; and
19	(3) if the vehicle is subject to odometer disclosure
20	under Section 501.072, an odometer disclosure statement on a secure
21	power of attorney form.
22	(c) If the department issues a title to a dealer under
23	Subsection (a), the dealer assumes liability for any outstanding
24	balance due to a lienholder on the motor vehicle and the lienholder

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- 1 may exercise any available legal remedy to collect the outstanding 2 balance.
- 3 (d) If a title issued to a dealer by the department under
- 4 Subsection (a) is later rescinded, canceled, or revoked under
- 5 <u>Section 501.051</u>, the department may revalidate a previously
- 6 <u>superseded or invalidated title.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
