A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the eligibility of certain first responders for
- 3 workers' compensation benefits for post-traumatic stress disorder
- 4 under the workers' compensation system.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 408.006(b), Labor Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) Notwithstanding Section 406.0061 [504.019], a mental or
- 9 emotional injury that arises principally from a legitimate
- 10 personnel action, including a transfer, promotion, demotion, or
- 11 termination, is not a compensable injury under this subtitle.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 504.019, Labor Code, is transferred to
- 13 Subchapter A, Chapter 408, Labor Code, redesignated as Section
- 14 408.0061, and amended to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 408.0061 [504.019]. COVERAGE FOR POST-TRAUMATIC
- 16 STRESS DISORDER FOR CERTAIN FIRST RESPONDERS. (a) In this section:
- 17 (1) "First responder" means an individual employed by
- 18 this state, a political subdivision of this state, or an
- 19 institution of higher education as defined by Section 61.003,
- 20 <u>Education Code</u>, who is:
- 21 (A) a peace officer under Article 2.12, Code of
- 22 Criminal Procedure;
- 23 (B) a person licensed under Chapter 773, Health
- 24 and Safety Code, as an emergency care attendant, emergency medical

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- 1 technician, emergency medical technician-intermediate, emergency
- 2 medical technician-paramedic, or licensed paramedic; or
- 3 (C) a firefighter subject to certification by the
- 4 Texas Commission on Fire Protection under Chapter 419, Government
- 5 Code, whose principal duties are firefighting and aircraft crash
- 6 and rescue.
- 7 (2) "Post-traumatic stress disorder" means a disorder
- 8 that meets the diagnostic criteria for post-traumatic stress
- 9 disorder specified by the American Psychiatric Association in the
- 10 Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, fifth
- 11 edition, or a later edition adopted by the commissioner of workers'
- 12 compensation.
- 13 (b) Post-traumatic stress disorder suffered by a first
- 14 responder is a compensable injury under this subtitle only if it is
- 15 based on a diagnosis that:
- 16 (1) the disorder is caused by one or more events
- 17 occurring in the course and scope of the first responder's
- 18 employment; and
- 19 (2) the preponderance of the evidence indicates that
- 20 the event or events were a producing cause of the disorder.
- (c) For purposes of this subtitle, the date of injury for
- 22 post-traumatic stress disorder suffered by a first responder is the
- 23 date on which the first responder first knew or should have known
- 24 that the disorder may be related to the first responder's
- 25 employment.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 27 a claim for workers' compensation benefits based on a compensable

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- 1 injury that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 2 claim based on a compensable injury that occurs before that date is
- 3 governed by the law as it existed on the date the compensable injury
- 4 occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 5 purpose.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
