4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 493, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 493.0165 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 493.0165. OMBUDSMAN OFFICE; REPORT. (a) The
8	department shall establish an ombudsman office to assist the
9	department in performing its duties under Section 493.016.
10	(b) The ombudsman office shall:
11	(1) establish a process by which an employee of the
12	department may anonymously submit a complaint regarding:
13	(A) the department;
14	(B) an inmate;
15	(C) another employee; or
16	(D) a facility operated by or under contract with
17	the department;
18	(2) investigate complaints submitted under
19	Subdivision (1); and
20	(3) refer complaints submitted under Subdivision (1)
21	involving criminal conduct to the appropriate agency for
22	investigation.
23	(c) The identity of an employee who submits a complaint
24	under Subsection (b) must remain anonymous unless the employee

1	chooses to disclose the employee's identity.
2	(d) Not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year,
3	the ombudsman office shall prepare and publish on the department's
4	Internet website a report that includes:
5	(1) the number of complaints submitted under
6	Subsection (b) during the two-year period preceding the date of the
7	report;
8	(2) a summary of any trends regarding the complaints;
9	and
10	(3) a description of the actions taken in response to
11	the complaints.
12	(e) The report described by Subsection (d) may not include
13	identifying information about any person involved in a complaint.
14	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
