- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 828.012, Health and Safety Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) A veterinarian employed by a releasing agency may not 9 perform nonemergency veterinary services other than sterilization 10 on an animal that the releasing agency knows or should know has an 11 owner. However, this subsection does not prevent a veterinarian 12 employed by a releasing agency from performing veterinary services 13 on an animal whose owner:

14 (1) is an individual or family whose income is:

- (A) not more than 50 percent of the median income

 for the area in which the individual or family lives as determined

 using a source or methodology accepted under federal law or rule; or

 (B) less than the federal poverty level for the

 relevant household size; and
- 20 (2) submits to the releasing agency evidence to
 21 establish the owner qualifies as an individual or family described
 22 by Subdivision (1) [is indigent].
- 23 <u>(b-1) If a veterinarian employed by a releasing agency</u> 24 performs veterinary services on an animal whose owner qualifies as

- 1 an individual or family described by Subsection (b)(1), the agency
- 2 <u>shall:</u>
- 3 (1) maintain the evidence the owner submits to the
- 4 agency under Subsection (b)(2); and
- 5 (2) on request of the State Board of Veterinary
- 6 Medical Examiners, make the evidence available to the board for
- 7 inspection.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
