- 6 SECTION 1. Section 47.002(f), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (f) A person who takes or assists in taking oysters on a
- 9 vessel licensed as a commercial oyster boat under Chapter 76 is
- 10 [not] required to obtain or possess a general commercial
- 11 fisherman's license. This subsection does not apply to the holder
- 12 of a commercial oyster boat captain's license.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 76.101(d), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (d) Each member of the crew of a licensed commercial oyster
- 16 boat is required to have a general commercial fisherman's license
- 17 to take oysters while they are on a licensed boat that is being used
- 18 to take oysters. This subsection does not apply to the holder of a
- 19 commercial oyster boat captain's license.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
