- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 49.273(d), (e), and (f), Water Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) For contracts over $\frac{$250,000}{$}$ [$\frac{$75,000}{$}$], the board shall
- 8 advertise the letting of the contract, including the general
- 9 conditions, time, and place of opening of sealed bids. The notice
- 10 must be published in one or more newspapers circulated in each
- 11 county in which the district is located. If there are more than
- 12 four counties in the district, notice may be published in any
- 13 newspaper with general circulation in the district. The notice
- 14 must be published once a week for two consecutive weeks before the
- 15 date that the bids are opened, and the first publication must be not
- 16 later than the 14th day before the date of the opening of the sealed
- 17 bids.
- (e) For contracts over $\frac{\$75,000}{\$25,000}$ [$\frac{\$25,000}{\$25,000}$] but not more than
- 19 $\frac{$250,000}{}$ [$\frac{$75,000}{}$], the board shall solicit written competitive
- 20 bids on uniform written specifications from at least three bidders.
- (f) For contracts of not more than $\frac{$75,000}{$}$ [$\frac{$25,000}{$}$], the
- 22 board is not required to advertise or seek competitive bids.
- 23 SECTION 2. Section 49.273, Water Code, as amended by this
- 24 Act, applies only to a contract for which a governmental entity

- 1 first advertises or otherwise requests bids, proposals, offers, or
- 2 qualifications, or makes a similar solicitation, on or after the
- 3 effective date of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
