A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment of an advisory committee to study suicide prevention and peer support programs in fire departments in 3 this state. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act: 6 7 (1)"Commission" means the Texas Commission on Fire Protection. 8 9 (2) "Fire department" has the meaning assigned by Section 419.021, Government Code. 10 11 (3) "Fire fighter" has the meaning assigned by Section 12 143.003, Local Government Code. SECTION 2. ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (a) The commission shall 13 14 establish an advisory committee to study the need to implement suicide prevention and peer support programs in fire departments in 15 16 this state. The committee is composed of the following members: (1) two fire fighters, appointed by the Texas State 17 Association of Firefighters; 18 (2) two fire fighters, appointed 19 by the State Firefighters' and Fire Marshals' Association of Texas; 20 21 (3) two fire chiefs, appointed by the Texas Fire 22 Chiefs Association; 23 (4) one person who is licensed to provide professional mental health services, as defined by Section 531.002, Health and 24

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1 Safety Code, appointed by the Texas Fire Chiefs Association;

(5) one person who is licensed to provide professional
mental health services as defined by Section 531.002, Health and
Safety Code, appointed by the Texas State Association of
Firefighters;

6 (6) one person who is licensed to provide professional
7 mental health services, as defined by Section 531.002, Health and
8 Safety Code, appointed by the State Firefighters' and Fire
9 Marshals' Association of Texas;

10 (7) one person, appointed by the executive director of
11 the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service; and

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(8) the executive director of the commission.

13 (b) The committee shall designate a member of the committee14 as chair of the committee.

15 (c) The commission may adopt rules necessary to carry out16 the purpose and duties of the committee under this Act.

17 (d) The commission shall provide administrative support and 18 resources necessary for the committee to carry out the purpose and 19 duties of the committee under this Act.

(e) The committee may meet in person or by telephoneconference, videoconference, or other electronic means.

SECTION 3. REPORT. Not later than September 1, 2024, the advisory committee shall prepare and submit a report to the governor and the legislature. The report must:

(1) provide an overview of suicide prevention and peer
support groups in fire departments;

EXPIRATION DATE. The advisory committee created by this Act is abolished and this Act expires January 10, 2025. 11 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September 12 13 1, 2023.
