H.B. No. 3582

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition and use of money in the flood
- 3 infrastructure fund.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 15.534, Water Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (a) The board may use the infrastructure fund only:
- 9 (1) to make a loan to an eligible political
- 10 subdivision at or below market interest rates for a flood project;
- 11 (2) to make a grant or loan at or below market interest
- 12 rates to an eligible political subdivision for a flood project to
- 13 serve <u>a rural</u> [an] area [outside of a metropolitan statistical
- 14 area] in order to ensure that the flood project is implemented;
- 15 (3) to make a loan at or below market interest rates
- 16 for planning and design costs, permitting costs, and other costs
- 17 associated with state or federal regulatory activities with respect
- 18 to a flood project;
- 19 (4) to make a grant to an eligible political
- 20 subdivision to provide matching funds to enable the eligible
- 21 political subdivision to participate in a federal program for a
- 22 flood project;
- 23 (5) to make a grant to an eligible political
- 24 subdivision for a flood project if the board determines that the

- 1 eligible political subdivision does not have the ability to repay a
- 2 loan;
- 3 (6) as a source of revenue or security for the payment
- 4 of principal and interest on bonds issued by the board if the
- 5 proceeds of the sale of the bonds will be deposited in the
- 6 infrastructure fund;
- 7 (7) to pay the necessary and reasonable expenses of
- 8 the board in administering the infrastructure fund; and
- 9 (8) to make transfers to the research and planning
- 10 fund created under Section 15.402 of this chapter.
- 11 (c) Except as provided by Subsections (a)(6)-(8), after the
- 12 adoption of the initial state flood plan, the board may use the
- 13 infrastructure fund to provide financing only for flood projects
- 14 included in the state flood plan.
- 15 (d) Money from the infrastructure fund may be awarded to
- 16 several eligible political subdivisions for a single flood project.
- SECTION 2. Section 16.454(j), Water Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 (j) This section expires September 1, 2031. The remaining
- 20 balance of the account on that date is transferred to the flood
- 21 <u>infrastructure fund</u> [plan implementation account].
- SECTION 3. The following provisions of Chapter 947 (S.B.
- 23 7), Acts of the 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019, are
- 24 repealed:
- 25 (1) Section 2.03; and
- 26 (2) Section 3.06.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
