- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.032(d), Human Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) In determining whether an applicant is eligible for
- 8 assistance, the commission shall exclude from the applicant's
- 9 available resources:
- 10 (1) \$5,000 [\$1,000] for the applicant's household,
- 11 including a household in which there is a person with a disability
- 12 or a person who is at least 60 years of age; and
- 13 (2) the fair market value of the applicant's ownership
- 14 interest in <u>one or more</u> [a] motor <u>vehicles:</u>
- 15 (A) not to exceed \$15,000 for the first motor
- 16 vehicle; and
- (B) not to exceed \$4,650 for each additional
- 18 motor vehicle [, but not more than \$5,000 plus or minus an amount to
- 19 be determined annually beginning on October 1, 1997, to reflect
- 20 changes in the new car component of the Consumer Price Index for All
- 21 Urban Consumers published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics].
- 22 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to an
- 23 initial determination or redetermination of eligibility of a person
- 24 for financial assistance under Chapter 31, Human Resources Code,

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- 1 that is made on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 3 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 4 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 5 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 6 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 7 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
