(a) A municipality that is divided into districts, 8 9 wards, or other areas from which members of its governing body are elected shall elect all members of the municipality's governing 10 body following each apportionment on the first uniform election 11 12 date that allows sufficient time to comply with any requirements of 13 law. 14 (b) If members of the governing body of a municipality described by Subsection (a) serve staggered terms, the municipality 15 16 shall adopt an equitable process to determine which members of the governing body serve shorter terms to accommodate an election 17 following apportionment that accounts for the remaining time in 18 each member's term and whether the term of any member elected from a 19
