5	SECTION 1. Sections 37.203(a) and (b), Education Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The center is advised by a board of directors composed

9	(1) the attorney general, or the attorney general's
10	designee;
11	(2) the commissioner, or the commissioner's designee;
12	(3) the executive director of the Texas Juvenile
13	Justice Department, or the executive director's designee;
14	(4) the commissioner of the Department of State Health
15	Services, or the commissioner's designee;
16	(5) the commissioner of higher education, or the
17	commissioner's designee; and
18	(6) the following members appointed by the governor
19	with the advice and consent of the senate:
20	(A) a juvenile court judge;
21	(B) a member of a school district's board of

- a school district police officer or a peace 8 officer whose primary duty consists of working in a public school; 9

- 15 Members of the board appointed under Subsection (a)(6) serve staggered two-year terms, with the terms of the members 16 17 described by Subsections (a)(6)(A)-(F) expiring on February 1 of each odd-numbered year and the terms of the members described by 18 19 Subsections (a)(6)(G)-(K) $[\frac{(a)(6)(G)-(J)}{(G)-(J)}]$ expiring on February 1 of each even-numbered year. A member may serve more than one term. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. Not later than February 1, 2024, the governor
- shall appoint the new member to the board of directors of the Texas 22
- 23 School Safety Center as required by Section 37.203(a)(6)(J),
- 24 Education Code, as amended by this Act.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
