- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.022, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) A school district may require a person who enters
- 9 property under the district's control [a district campus] to
- 10 display the person's driver's license  $\underline{L}$  [ $\frac{\partial L}{\partial L}$ ] another form of
- 11 identification containing the person's photograph issued by a
- 12 governmental entity, or, if applicable, the person's district
- 13 employee or student identification card. The person must provide
- 14 the identification on request.
- 15 (a-1) A school district may eject a person from district
- 16 property if:
- 17 (1) the person refuses or fails to provide on request
- 18 identification described by Subsection (a); and
- 19 (2) it reasonably appears that the person has no
- 20 <u>legitimate reason to be on district property.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 22 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
