4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 61.09093 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 61.09093. HEALTHY MINDS CAMPUS PROGRAM. (a) The board
8	shall establish and administer a Healthy Minds Campus program under
9	which the board shall designate a campus of an institution of higher
10	education as a Healthy Minds Campus if the institution:
11	(1) applies to the board in the manner prescribed by
12	board rule;
13	(2) designates a staff member of the institution as a
14	mental health liaison, whose duties include:
15	(A) identifying students enrolled at the
16	institution in need of prevention programs and telehealth services;
17	(B) determining appropriate evidence-based
18	mental health trainings for faculty and staff;
19	(C) gathering and reporting data to encourage
20	information sharing across institutions of higher education; and
21	(D) assisting in coordinating mental health
22	awareness events on campus;
23	(3) implements mental health awareness programs to
24	inform students about mental health conditions and available

1	resources;
2	(4) provides training for students, faculty, and staff
3	regarding recognizing and addressing the mental health needs of
4	students, which may include an evidence-based mental health first
5	aid training program;
6	(5) provides peer support programs to improve the
7	emotional well-being of students by using student peers to support
8	individuals living with mental health conditions on campus; and
9	(6) collaborates with local mental health service
10	providers in the campus's surrounding communities to improve mental
11	health services capacity.
12	(b) Under the Healthy Minds Campus program, the board may:
13	(1) provide access to mental health programs and
14	gather student mental health data for institutions with the Healthy
15	Minds Campus designation; and
16	(2) promote mental health resource sharing across
17	institutions of higher education.
18	(c) The board may adapt the rubric developed by the Texas
19	Education Agency under Section 38.251 for use by institutions of
20	higher education in implementing mental health services and
21	programs.
22	(d) The board shall adopt rules as necessary to administer
23	this section.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
