- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5.001, Civil Practice and Remedies Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), in any action
- 8 governed by the laws of this state concerning rights and
- 9 <u>obligations under the law, a publication by the American Law</u>
- 10 Institute, including a restatement or model code, may not be
- 11 considered to represent the laws of this state and may not be wholly
- or partly relied on by a court for a ruling on a motion or a judgment
- 13 <u>if the publication in its final form was published after December</u>
- 14 31, 1999.

- (d) Subsection (c) does not apply to a provision in a
- 16 publication by the American Law Institute that:
- 17 (1) appeared in its exact form in a publication of the
- 18 American Law Institute published in its final form before January
- 19 1, 2000;
- 20 (2) is identical to or affirmatively adopted by a law
- 21 enacted by the legislature; or
- 22 (3) is identical to the common law of this state
- 23 without reference to any publication published after December 31,
- 24 1999.

- 1 SECTION 2. Sections 5.001(c) and (d), Civil Practice and
- 2 Remedies Code, as added by this Act, apply only to an action pending
- 3 on or filed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
