4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 12, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 12.2551 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 12.2551. ALTERNATIVE AUTHORIZATION. (a)
8	Notwithstanding any other law and in addition to the other
9	permissible methods for establishing a charter or campus under this
10	chapter, the commissioner shall, on the basis of an application
11	submitted, grant a charter under the program to the entities
12	described by Subsection (b) to provide an adult education program
13	for individuals described by Section 12.258 to successfully
14	<pre>complete:</pre>
15	(1) a high school program that can lead to a diploma;
16	and
17	(2) career and technology education courses that can
18	<pre>lead to industry certification.</pre>
19	(b) The following entities are eligible to submit an
20	application under Subsection (a):
21	(1) the board of trustees of a school district or the
22	governing body of a home-rule school district that has entered into
23	a contract under Section 11.157 with a nonprofit entity described
24	by Section 12.256 to operate the program;

- 1 (2) a public junior college or public senior college
- 2 or university, as those terms are defined by Section 61.003, that
- 3 has entered into a contract with a nonprofit entity described by
- 4 Section 12.256 to operate the program; and
- 5 (3) a governmental entity that has entered into a
- 6 contract with a nonprofit entity described by Section 12.256 to
- 7 operate the program.
- 8 <u>(c) The provisions of this chapter, including provisions</u>
- 9 related to assessment, accountability, and funding, govern a
- 10 program authorized under this section.
- 11 (d) The provisions of Section 12.255 do not apply to a
- 12 charter granted under this section.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
