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- 2 relating to the establishment of the Rural Workforce Training Grant
- 3 Program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 302.0039 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 302.0039. RURAL WORKFORCE TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM. (a)
- 8 In this section, "program" means the Rural Workforce Training Grant
- 9 Program established under this section.
- 10 (b) The commission shall establish and administer the Rural
- 11 Workforce Training Grant Program for the purpose of providing
- 12 targeted funding for job-specific workforce training and related
- 13 <u>services</u> to strengthen the skills, resources, and career
- 14 opportunities of the rural workforce in this state.
- 15 (c) Under the program, the commission shall award grants to
- 16 public, private, or nonprofit entities, including business
- 17 associations, political subdivisions, local workforce development
- 18 boards, and educational institutions, that:
- (1) provide on-the-job training, apprenticeships,
- 20 workforce education courses, and other job-specific workforce
- 21 development activities in a county with a population of less than
- 22 200,000; and
- 23 (2) apply to the commission in the manner provided by
- 24 commission rule.

- 1 (d) Grant money awarded to an entity under the program may
- 2 be used only to cover costs associated with training materials,
- 3 instructors' fees, participant wraparound expenses, facility fees,
- 4 administrative costs, and outreach, mentoring, and recruiting
- 5 costs for the training, apprenticeship, course, or other activity
- 6 for which the money is awarded.
- 7 <u>(e) The commission shall require a grant recipient to</u>
- 8 provide periodic reports regarding the recipient's use of grant
- 9 money received under the program and related training participant
- 10 <u>outcomes.</u>
- 11 (f) The commission may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
- 12 donations from any public or private source for purposes of the
- 13 program.
- 14 (g) The commission shall adopt rules for the administration
- of the program.
- (h) Not later than December 1 of each year, the commission
- 17 shall submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker
- 18 of the house of representatives, and the standing committee of each
- 19 house of the legislature with primary jurisdiction over workforce
- 20 development matters a report regarding:
- 21 (1) the grants awarded under the program during the
- 22 most recent state fiscal year; and
- 23 (2) the program's effectiveness.
- 24 SECTION 2. The Texas Workforce Commission shall adopt the
- 25 rules required under Section 302.0039(g), Labor Code, as added by
- 26 this Act, as soon as practicable after the effective date of this
- 27 Act.
