Subchapter G, Chapter 38, Education Code, is 4 5 amended by adding Section 38.354 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 38.354. FENTANYL AWARENESS PROGRAM. (a) Each school district and open-enrollment charter school shall adopt a fentanyl 7 awareness program to educate students, parents, and school 8 9 personnel regarding the dangers posed by the use of the drug fentanyl. The district or school shall incorporate the applicable 10 components of the program adopted under this section: 11 12 (1) for students enrolled in elementary school, as part of the district's or school's physical education curriculum 13 14 under Section 28.002(a)(2)(C) or through a program provided by a school nurse; and 15 (2) for students enrolled in middle school, junior 16 high school, or high school, as part of the district's or school's 17 health curriculum under Section 28.002(a)(2)(B). 18 (b) The agency shall assist in the development of programs 19 under this section by providing information and a list of available 20 resources relating to the establishment of a fentanyl awareness 21 program by a school district or open-enrollment charter school. 22 23 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the effective date of this Act, a school district or open-enrollment charter school is not required 24

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1 to adopt a fentanyl awareness program under Section 38.354,
2 Education Code, as added by this Act, before August 1, 2024.
3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
