## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to civil and criminal liability for pharmacists and
3	pharmacies that dispense misoprostol.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle H, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 180 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 180. LIMITATIONS ON LIABILITY FOR PROVISION OF HEALTH CARE
8	<u>SERVICES</u>
9	Sec. 180.001. LIMITED LIABILITY FOR DISPENSING
10	MISOPROSTOL. Notwithstanding any other law, a pharmacist or
11	pharmacy is not civilly or criminally liable for dispensing
12	misoprostol, as prescribed by a physician, for use in the treatment
13	of a medical condition if at least one use of misoprostol is
14	authorized under state law to treat a medical condition, regardless
15	of whether prescribing or dispensing misoprostol for another use is

illegal under state law.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
